<i>Christensonia vietnamica</i> – beautiful lime-green flowers, white lip. mounted	£15
<i>Chytroglossa marilionae</i> – beautiful cool growing miniature, mounted	£16
<i>Comparettia coccinea</i> – scarlet flowered cool Brazilian species	£10
<i>Dendrobium alaticaulinum</i> – cool, pink flower clusters, pendent, New Guinea	£10
<i>Dendrobium aphanochilum</i> – New Guinea Pedilonum, clustered white flowers	£10
<i>Dendrobium (Cadetia) chionanthum</i> - F/S white flowered compact alpine type	£22
<i>Dendrobium chrysopterum</i> - pendent with orange/yellow flowers, New Guinea	£10
<i>Dendrobium cruttwellii</i> – small plant with pendulous greenish flowers	£12
<i>Dendrobium cuthbertsonii</i> – aka <i>D. agathodaemonis</i> , red cuthbertsonii flower but different growth form, without pseudobulbs. Easier to manage	£15
<i>Dendrobium cuthbertsonii</i> (red x yellow)	£15
<i>Dendrobium eyanthum</i> – small, attractive Latourea like rhodostictum	£15
<i>Dendrobium leucocyanum</i> – compact miniature; ice green flower clusters mounted	£15
<i>Dendrobium limpidum</i> – compact miniature; potted or mounted	£12
<i>Dendrobium mohlianum</i> – from Fiji, lovely deep red flowers	£10
<i>Dendrobium moniliforme</i> – cool growing with crystalline white flowers.	£10
<i>Dendrobium porphyrochilum</i> – (F/S) yellow flowers with purple lip	£15
<i>Dendrobium subacaule</i> – v. special miniature potted or mounted F/S	£22
<i>D. subclausum</i> ssp. <i>subclausum</i> – orange/yellow cool grower	£10
<i>Dendrobium venustum</i> a small Thai species, intermediate, cool, dryer winter	£10
<i>Dendrobium vexillarius</i> v. <i>retroflexum</i> – ‘The Blue One!’	£15
<i>Dendrobium wardianum</i> – intermediate, bright light, dry winter spell.	£10
<i>Dendrochilum javierii</i> – cool growing, yellow flower spikes in spring	£9
<i>Dendrochilum undulatum</i> – probably the largest flower in the genus	£9
<i>Diplocaulobium chrysotropis</i> – scented ephemeral flowers; mounted F/S	£15
<i>Dryadella edwalii</i> – cool growing Brazilian with many yellow blotchy flowers	£9
<i>Encyclia polybulbon</i> – creeping miniature, flowering size, mounted.	£12
<i>Epidendrum stamfordianum</i> – Near F/S, intermediate from C. America	£12
<i>Gomesa glaziovii</i> – delightful alpine species with dangling inflorescences	£9
<i>Haraella retrocalla</i> – pretty miniature, free flowering, mounted F/S	£12

<i>Hygrochilus parishii</i> – cool growing winter flowering (mounted)	£12
<i>Laelia crispa</i> – beautiful white and purple flowers, cool to intermediate	£9
<i>Maxillaria chrysantha</i> – (large F/S) golden yellow and red-spotted lip	£17
<i>Maxillaria cogniauxiana</i> – tufted miniature with deep red flowers in spring	£10
<i>Maxillaria kautskyii</i> – orange flowers from Brazil	£10
<i>Mediocalcar decoratum</i> - flowering size, mounted	£15
<i>Neocogniauxia monophylla</i> – scarlet flowered, cool growing gem;	£16
<i>Odontoglossum crispum</i> – classic white flowers with deep red markings.	£10
<i>Odontoglossum x excellens</i> – natural hybrid, cool growing	£10
<i>Odontoglossum hallii</i> – fast growing, yellow, white and chestnut – lovely	£9
<i>Odontoglossum naevium</i> – white with red markings, yellow lip	£12.50
<i>Oncidium batemannianum</i> – bright yellow flowers on six month inflorescence	£10
<i>Oncidium cogniauxianum</i> – perfect miniature, regular butter yellow flowers	£10
<i>Pleurothallis restrepioides</i> - flowering size	£12
<i>Pleurothallis secunda</i> – flowering size	£12
<i>Pleurothallis leptotifolium</i> – mounted F/S, terete leaves, pale yellow flowers	£12
<i>Sophronitis grandiflora</i> – best strain of this magic scarlet Brazilian	£12
<i>Warmingia eugenii</i> – cool growing multi-flowered in crystalline white	£9
<i>Zygostates grandiflora</i> – white flowered miniature with green lip	£12
