<b>Dendrobium moniliforme</b> – cool growing with crystalline white flowers.	£10
Dendrobium subacaule – v. special miniature potted or mounted F/S	£22
Dendrobium subuliferum - F/S superb white flowers, purple anther	£30
Dendrobium sulphureum x nardoides – long lived Oxyglossum cross, (F/S)	£18
Dendrobium wardianum - intermediate, bright light, dry winter spell.	£10
Dendrochilum javierii - cool growing, yellow flower spikes in spring	£12
Dendrochilum undulatum – probably the largest flower in the genus	£15
Diplocaulobium chrysotropis – scented ephemeral flowers; mounted F/S	£15
Dryadella edwalii – cool growing Brazilian with many yellow blotchy flowers	£12
Encyclia polybulbon – creeping miniature, flowering size, mounted.	£12
