<b><i>Bulbophyllum campos-portoi</i></b> – weird pendent inflorescences; Brazil(F/S)	£12
<b><i>Cadetia chionantha</i></b> – see <i>Dendrobium chionanthum</i>	
<b><i>Capanemia therezae</i></b> – tiny twig epiphyte with modest but scented flowers.	£12
<b><i>Christensonia vietnamica</i></b> – beautiful lime-green flowers, white lip. mounted	£15
<b><i>Comparettia coccinea</i></b> – scarlet flowered cool Brazilian species	£10
<b><i>Dendrobium alaticaulinum</i></b> – cool, pink flower clusters, pendent, New Guinea	£15
<b><i>Dendrobium brassii</i></b> – compact small New Guinea, long lasting pink flowers.	£18
<b><i>Dendrobium bulbophylloides</i></b> – creeping mini with frequent fleshy flowers	£22
<b><i>Dendrobium (Cadetia) chionanthum</i></b> - F/S white flowers compact alpine type	£22
<b><i>Dendrobium cruttwellii</i></b> – small plant with pendulous greenish flowers	£12
<b><i>Dendrobium cuthbertsonii</i></b> (red x yellow)	£15
<b><i>Dendrobium eximium</i></b> – most flashy of the Latourea group.	£12
<b><i>Dendrobium eyanthum</i></b> – small, attractive Latourea like rhodostictum	£15
<b><i>Dendrobium forbesii</i></b> - Cattleya-like in growth, repeat flowering.	£12
<b><i>Dendrobium leucocyanum</i></b> – compact miniature; ice blue clusters, mounted	£22
<b><i>Dendrobium limpidum</i></b> – compact miniature; potted or mounted	£18
<b><i>Dendrobium moniliforme</i></b> – cool growing with crystalline white flowers.	£10
<b><i>Dendrobium subacaule</i></b> - tiny red and orange ‘twigs aflame’!	£22
<b><i>Dendrobium subuliferum</i></b> - F/S superb white flowers, purple anther	£30
<b><i>Dendrobium sulphureum</i></b> – many yellow flowers like a mini vexillarius.	£16
<b><i>Dendrobium sulphureum x nardooides</i></b> – long lived Oxyglossum cross, (F/S)	£18.
<b><i>Dendrochilum javierii</i></b> – cool growing, yellow flower spikes in spring	£12
<b><i>Dendrochilum undulatum</i></b> – probably the largest flower in the genus	£15
<b><i>Diplocaulobium chrysotropis</i></b> – scented ephemeral flowers; mounted F/S	£15
<b><i>Dryadella edwalii</i></b> – cool growing Brazilian with many yellow blotchy flowers	£12
<b><i>Encyclia polybulbon</i></b> – creeping miniature, flowering size, mounted.	£12
<b><i>Epidendrum stamfordianum</i></b> – Near F/S, intermediate from C. America	£12
<b><i>Esmeralda cathcartii</i></b> - mounted vandaceous; much sought after	£12
<b><i>Gomesa glaziovii</i></b> – delightful alpine species with dangling inflorescences	£9
<b><i>Laelia crispa</i></b> – beautiful white and purple flowers, cool to intermediate	£9
<b><i>Maxillaria chrysantha</i></b> – (large F/S) golden yellow and red-spotted lip	£17
<b><i>Maxillaria cogniauxiana</i></b> – tufted miniature with deep red flowers in spring	£10

<i>Maxillaria schunkeana</i> – compact mini. (F/S) are the flowers really black?	£17
<i>Mediocalcar decoratum</i> - flowering size, mounted. Orange/yellow flowers.	£15
<i>Neocogniauxia monophylla</i> – scarlet flowered, cool growing gem;	£16
<i>Odontoglossum crispum</i> – classic; white flowers blotched red.	£12
<i>Odontoglossum x excellens</i> – natural hybrid, cool growing	£10
<i>Odontoglossum hallii</i> – fast growing, yellow, white and chestnut – lovely	£9
<i>Odontoglossum naevium</i> – white with red markings, yellow lip	£12.50
<i>Odontoglossum odoratum</i> – fast growing, scented, chestnut and gold.	£10
<i>Odontoglossum wyattianum</i> – strong seedlings, rich brown, purple striped lip.	£12
<i>Oncidium batemannianum</i> – bright yellow flowers on six month inflorescence	£10
<i>Oncidium cogniauxianum</i> – perfect miniature, regular butter yellow flowers	£10
<i>Pleurothallis restrepioides</i> – flowering size	£12
<i>Pleurothallis secunda</i> – flowering size	£12
<i>Pleurothallis leptotifolium</i> – mounted F/S, terete leaves, pale yellow flowers	£12
<i>Polystachya clareae</i> – bright orange-yellow flower clusters	£15
<i>Promenaea xanthina</i> – small plants, silky leaves, butter yellow flowers.	£10
<i>Sophranitella violacea</i> – small compact multi-flowered, rich deep pink. F/S	£16
<i>Sophranitis grandiflora</i> – best strain of this magic scarlet Brazilian	£18
<i>Zygopetalum intermedium</i> – scented, indigo flowers; terrestrial	£12
<i>Zygopetalum microphytum</i> – smallest of the Zygopetalums, purple lip.	£12
<i>Zygostates grandiflora</i> – white flowered miniature, green lip; some in bud	£15

**TERRESTRIAL SPECIES** all are near flowering size, sent bare root in sphagnum moss.

<i>Bonatea speciosa</i> – tall inflorescences with green flowers and white lips	£12
<i>Cranichis candida</i> – winter, white-flowered ghostly sentinel, cool, Brazil	£15
<i>Stenoglottis longifolia</i> – pink flowers, decorative, spotted leaves.	£12
<i>Stenorrhynchos speciosus</i> – attractive variegated leaves and red flowers	£15
